BERNARDO COCKBURN received his PhD from the University of Chicago in 1986 under the direction of Jim Douglas, Jr.

In the academic year 1986/87, he was a postdoc at the IMA in Minnesota. In 1987, he joined the School of Mathematics at the University of Minnesota.

In 2007, he became a McKnight Distinguished University Professor.

He is an ISIS Highly Cited author and was an Invited Speaker at the 2010 International Congress of Mathematicians.

Prof. Cockburn is best known for work on discontinuous Galerkin methods for partial differential equations.
