



Ramón Losada is PhD Architect from the School of Architecture of Madrid since 1980 and full professor at the Department of Mechanical Engineering of the University of the Basque Country since 1989.

His main areas of research are focused on sustainable urban planning, sustainability of materials and building systems and evaluating building and sustainability in various areas within the construction engineering.

He has participated in 10 research projects, 3 of them as main investigator.

Author of 17 books in collaboration, 18 scientific papers, 18 communications at national and international conferences and 7 PhD theses supervisor.

In his professional career as an architect has held various municipal offices and government, has won several architectural awards and has authored numerous architectural projects, most notably Kutxabank headquarters in Bilbao, the new headquarters for the Port Authority of Bilbao Santurtzi and Executive Management Construction Building Auditorium of the UPV / EHU (Project Alvaro Siza).
